 - allows for Grade 9 students to have a strong year of academics where the teachers can focus on one Grade instruction instead of a split Grade.

 - Looking into the cost of a 8 day trip to Hawaii.
 - Will also look into other trip costs both domestic and international, since Hawaii might be a lot more.
 - Once the estimated cost is submitted, Miss Hensch will bring the trips to a student vote to help pick which one, then she will write a proposal to the Board.
 - Target date would be in about 2 years to allow for fundraising
