5.1 Playground update

President Jen has had discussions with three playground companies

- Play Quest
 - They will be mailing Brochures to Smith School
 - They have put in the splash park in Slave lake so we know they are able to come to a more remote space.
 - They have a person who can help apply for grants
- Blue Imp
 - Minimal contact between company and Jen but is still in the process of having the communication
- Play Craft
 - Located in Nisku
 - They are willing to come out to Smith School to discuss the location, needs and wants with no financial obligation. And willing to come out with us not committing to that company
 - The company was originally a construction (GLVConstruction) company who put in playgrounds and had good success with Play craft and then worked independently with them.
 - Warranty with this company and with playcraft
 - They will provide with detailed quote
 - They have an employee who will help with grants

- They will provide a rendering of the playground so we can use it for fundraising and informational purposes.

5.2 FSLW- Supports offered for students and Families presented by Rebecca Weber

- Becca is paid by the Municipality district of lesser slave lake and Aspenview School District
- She supports students and families with wellness needs (academic, wellness, emotional. ETC.)
- She has introduced Kelso's choice to the kindergarten to grade 2 (provided by district)
 - She has given lesson in the classroom
 - Provided visual aids across the school
 - Students have been verbally reminded and have shown use of it.
- She supports with academic success
 - Providing fidgets for kids when they need it.
 - Encouraging motivational skills
 - Helping set goals with students
 - Communicating with staff, students and parents
- Becca is building a folder providing different support from neighbouring communities.
- Her practise is build on trust, confidentiality
 - If information needs to be shared she will ask permission from the party
 - Information is kept safe
 - Within the school Jen Borgen can be looped in as she is out of districts she is the student councilor.
- Parent sessions (\$1500)
 - District (Kim Carson) has given the Task to all FSL to use \$1500 to help support parents
 - This could be a informational season or multiple sessions
 - Live sessions
 - Recorded sessions
 - The money could be put towards food and Childcare
 - What do parents want to see?

- Sending home a survey to get a grasp of what the community parents want to see.
- Ideas/topics the council had
 - Sessions on Burn out, Children, Teenagers, Phones, Homework
 - A parenting comedian
 - Someone who comes in a shares stories and advice in a funny manner

- Student Sessions (\$500)
 - Similar to parents sessions but geared towards the students
 - More focus on
 - Bullying
 - Mental health
 - Internet safety
 - Completed before June 2025
